Te Mahi - The Role...

Totara Hospice has just entered the Generation 3 phase of its journey. We have an integrated care management style that follows and supports the patient's journey at all points, and which is underpinned by a Te Whare Tapa Wha approach where the team collaborates in partnership with the patient and whānau. Multidisciplinary case conferencing provides a cornerstone for all service delivery.

Situated at Totara House, Te Puna Ora o Totara (The Totara Living Well Centre) offers a range of programmes, education sessions and therapies, all focused on living well, maximising patient's independence and social connections. It provides an opportunity for a change in environment, and an opportunity to meet others who are on a similar journey.

Your key focus in this role would be to coordinate and oversee the suite of Patient and Family programmes offered as part of the Te Puna Ora O Totara service. You will also independently, but as part of the community, and multi-disciplinary team in collaboration with General Practitioners, District Nurses, Volunteers, and hospital staff, provide palliative care to patients with life limiting illness and their families/whanau.
